Plants tolerate a wide range of conditions but will stay more compact when allowed to dry out between waterings.

<b>Garden conditions</b>
--------------------------

Grows well in full sun and xeric conditions. Has been seen growing in the wild on sandy road-sides with cacti. The drier the setting, the more compact the plant. Additional water can result in leggy plants. Combines well with shorter native grasses where the plant can sprawl and dot the garden with its chocolate fragrance and bright-yellow flowers.
