Cuttings				
Treatments (Suggested procedures)				
Cuttings should be about 2" and taken from non-flowering stems. Use a 1:10 rooting hormone and put cuttings under intermittent mist until root development begins. Seeds germinate readily but hybridization is common.				
Collection Timing and Strategies				
Take cuttings on non-flowering terminals. Easier in short days.				
Cultural Information				
Greenhouse conditions				
Start at 70F and 70% humidity, will typically callus in 2 weeks. Gradually reduce temperature and humidity. Fertilizer levels should be medium. Normally pinch plants between days 21 and 28.				
Garden conditions				
Other Expert Advice				
Florel at 500ppm will help reduce buds and blooms and produce more lateral growth.
