Light: All grow best in full sun

Moisture: The drier the better, once plants are established

Culture: Drainage is essential—best in soils with low organic content

A combination of North American native shrubs, perennials and groundcovers, this garden is sure to draw a plethora of pollinators including bees, butterflies and hummingbirds. Wild Thing sage, SILVERTON® penstemon and KANNAH CREEK® buckwheat provide stunning color in the springtime while the others steal the show from mid-summer through fall. For additional texture, add some native grasses to the mix such as Blonde Ambition blue gramma grass or UNDAUNTED® ruby muhly.
