Easy to propagate from cuttings. Take softwood cuttings on non-blooming plants, remove lower leaves and dip into rooting hormone. We use Hormodin 2 powder. Cuttings are placed in a moist mixture of 2 parts perlite to 1 part bagged sterile soil mix (peat and perlite), under intermittent mist. Bottom heat helps promote rooting, but is not absolutely necessary.
