Treatments (Suggested procedures)				
<p>Very easy to propagate from cuttings, often offering adventitious roots along the prostrate stem. Take cuttings of about 2 inches, remove leaves from lower 3/4s of the stem and dip into rooting hormone. We use Hormodin 2 powder. Cuttings are placed in a moist mixture of 2 parts Perlite to 1 part bagged sterile soil mix (peat and perlite), under intermittent mist. Bottom heat helps promote rooting, but is not absolutely necessary.</p>				
Collection Timing and Strategies				
<p>We have found that cuttings can be taken from non-blooming plants at almost any time. Rooting can take from 2 to 4 weeks depending on the conditions (longer under cooler conditions). A very "forgiving" plant to take cuttings from!</p>
