Treatments (Suggested procedures)				
Let runners develop a rosette that is at least 1" wide this usually occurs by late June when grown outdoors in a garden.				
Collection Timing and Strategies				
Collect runners (rosettes) in late June to late July stick in a flat filled 2" deep with 2/3's perlite, 1/3 peat, place flat in a mist bed, keep them under mist until rooting occurs this take about 3-4 weeks. Transplant into a 2 1/2" pot for sales in the Spring.				
Cultural Information				
Greenhouse conditions				
Grow in a cool greenhouse until plants have filled pots.				
Garden conditions				
Plants do well in a well drained soil, with some afternoon shade. Will grow up to very high elevations at least 10,000 ft.
