3 days leach followed by 30 days cold will start to germinate in refrigerator. Keep peat media on the dry side. A 6 hour H2O2 soak then direct sow without strat works in a pinch but with lower germ rate. Too much moisture detrimental				
Collection Timing and Strategies				
Gary Epstein only has found it growing on a buff colored slick sandstone. He collects just south of Blanding, UT on Hwy 191 then turn west on Hwy 95 go 14 miles to just pass mile marker 107 as the road cuts through the buff sandstone layer. Best seed found along both sides of the road. Beware! some years there will be biting gnats active that cause severe itching. Wear long sleeves and pants and liberally use repellent as it gives some control. Also can find it growing just west of Paradox, CO about mid-June; Sometimes available from Alplains Seed Co.
