<b>Treatments</b> (Suggested procedures)				
<p>Take softwood tip cuttings in June during active growth and before the terminal bud develops. Spray over the top with 1000ppm of water soluble IBA, and place under intermittent mist. The secret is to take cuttings from young plants. Avoid collecting cuttings from older plants as juvenile wood is necessary for adequate rooting percentages. Seed is possible but the seed coat is very hard and thick so it takes two years to germinate and the success is limited.</p>
