Treatments (Suggested procedures)				
No pretreatment or rooting hormone is necessary. This Delosperma roots readily (just don't over water the cuttings). You should expect to get 99% to 100% take on cuttings you stick. We place our cuttings in 32 count flats with no problems. You could also use smaller sizes 128s etc.				
Collection Timing and Strategies				
Divisions and cuttings can be taken at any time, but actively growing plants are best! Plants must be kept on the dry side for best results.				
Cultural Information				
Greenhouse conditions				
Keep on the moderate to dry side, but this plant is forgiving and will survive under adverse conditions. Don't over fertilize and be sure to vernalize plants to get blooms.				
Garden conditions				
Full sun but will tolerate light shade, likes it on the dry side with minimal care.				
Other Expert Advice				
This Delosperma needs vernalization to flower! Don't over fertilize or the plants may get leggy and be short lived. Iron is helpful if stock plants start to yellow in pots.
