| <p>Typically germinates in 8 - 14 days. Plants germinate at a higher rate when not covered. No preconditioning of seed is required. Cuttings taken from non-flowering stems will root with a mild hormonal treatment and with mist for the first 3 - 5 days. Root initiation can take up to 4 weeks.</p> | | | | |
