<p>Germination occurs in 2 days at 80°F. and 90% RH. Sow plants into jumbo packs or 2 1/2" pots. Plants will root out in 2 weeks at 65 - 70°F. Seed to finish is usually 4weeks.</p>

<p>Plants should be grown dry to avoid elongation of internodes, plants do well with medium to high levels of fertilizer.</p>				
Garden conditions				
<p>Best grown in full sun. Plants can tolerate drier locations but will get very large with more irrigation. Shade diminishes blooming and foliage color.</p>
