Plants germinate well after 14 day cold moist stratification followed by germination in a heated greenhouse between 70 days and 55 nights.					

Collection Timing and Strategies

Seed ripens in August. This plant is quite difficult to clean. A hammermil to free seed from seed heads is almost a must have item. Seeds within the flowerhead matures at quite different times. The best seed is a light tan color and is cone shaped rather than flat.

Cultural Information

Greenhouse conditions

Once seedlings have been transplanted they can be moved to a 70 - 40 greenhouse. Allow plants to dry between waterings

Garden conditions

Plant in a sunny location with good east facing exposure as flowers always face that direction.
