Treatments (Suggested procedures)				
Seed requires light to germinate, do not cover. Seeds are also very fragile and will crush if not handled a little more carefully than most seed. Seed takes between 4-10 days to germinate				
Collection Timing and Strategies				
Most years seed is collected in late October and into November. Seed must be hand cleaned to avoid crushing.				
Cultural Information				
Greenhouse conditions				
Do not exclude light during germination. Plants prefer a well ventilated area and a well draining media. Putting 2 or 3 seedlings can make a better looking plant faster.				
Garden conditions				
Plants do best in full hot sun. very xeric. Only occasional watering in the hottest time of the year. Plants are also late to break dormancy.				
Other Expert Advice				
Weekly Zero-Tol drench can help to prevent damping off. Putting 2 or 3 seedlings can make a better looking plant faster.
