Treatments (Suggested procedures)				
Cuttings can be taken anytime the plant is actively growing. Cuttings should be at least 2" of stem and dipped in rooting hormone stuck in a very fast draining rooting media and placed under intermittent mist for 3 days. Remove from mist and allow to root watering only as needed to keep plants from wilting.				
Collection Timing and Strategies				
Take cuttings any time plant is actively growing from April to September on outdoor stock plants. Plants are also easily dividable any time of year.
