Easy to grow, with no abnormal insect or disease problems. Tolerant of a wide range of growing conditions. Feed twice per week with up to 200 p.p.m. Nitrogen fertilizer.			
Garden conditions			
Should be grown in full sun, but will also grow in partial shade. Grows in loam (preferred), sandy loam, or clay loam soils. Clay soil or excessively well- drained soils should be avoided. Tolerates dry to moist soil conditions, but moist soil conditions in the winter can cause root rot diseases. Water once per week during dry periods if it is grown in a xeriscape garden.
