Cuttings		Mid-Western U.S. Cultivated		
<b>Treatments</b> (Suggested procedures)				
Cuttings should be taken from non-flowering stems that are still pliable. Cuttings should have at least one node above the soil and one node below. Treat cuttings with a 1:10 liquid rooting compound and stick in a 1:3 peat:perlite and place under intermittent mist for up to 3 weeks.				
<b>Collection Timing and Strategies</b>				
<b>Cultural Information</b>				
Greenhouse conditions				
Grow plants on the dry side and shear regularly to promote a well branched plant. This is a vine and needs a trellis to support it.				
Garden conditions				
Plant in full sun and in a well drained soil that receives regular watering. Give the plant something to grow on, Either a wall, fence, trellis etc.				
<b>Other expert Advice</b>				
Keep water off of the foliage to prevent washing off the waxy cutin layer that gives plants their color.
