Cuttings should be taken from non-flowering stems and need to have at least 2 nodes, preferably 4. Do not place under intermittent mist, hand water or sub-irrigate. Seed germinates in about 6 days and does not need to be covered.

Collect seed in the fall when bracts have dried and turned brown. Seeds are very difficult to clean and most plants do not produce high yields. Cuttings can be taken any time the plant is growing non-flowering stems.
