Treatments (Suggested procedures)				
Take 1½ - 2" tip cuttings and treat with 0.1% IBA rooting talc or 1:10 liquid rooting hormone. Stick cuttings in a well-drained medium and place under intermittent mist. Root initiation takes place in about 6 - 8 days, and 128-cell plug trays are ready to transplant in 6 - 8 weeks.				
Collection Timing and Strategies				
Collect cuttings any time that the plant is producing vegetative growth. Do not take cuttings from flowering stems.				
Cultural Information				
Greenhouse conditions				
Feed twice per week with 75-100 ppm Nitrogen fertilizer. Excess feed and water can cause undesirable stem elongation. Shear stock plants frequently to keep plants in vegetative growth cycle. May be susceptible to Rhizoctonia crown rot if overwatered.				
Garden conditions				
Can be grown in a variety of soil conditions including sand, clay, or loam. Full sun is ideal for the most compact growth, but it will also grow well in partial shade. Soil moisture should be maintained at moderate to xeric levels.				
Other Expert Advice				
Deadhead to encourage re-blooming. Aromatic foliage is reportedly more fragrant when grown in lean soils.
