Treatments (Suggested procedures)				
<p>Pawnee Buttes® can be rooted by taking 5 to 6 inch long softwood tip cuttings (don't cut the tip, so they continue to grow to help them survive the winter) Cut the bottom cut 1/4" below the node and have that node stuck below media level. Spray over the top with 1000 ppm water soluble IBA (phytotronics 20% water soluble IBA) placed under intermittent mist. They root OK with about 70% success. The problem with Pawnee Buttes is powdery mildew. It's probably better to preventative spray the stock plants with Eagle 20 just to keep them healthy enough to get good mildew-free cuttings.</p>
