Treatments (Suggested procedures)			
January--90 days cold. Extremely sensitive to transplant shock. Transplant then place under intermittent mist x 3 days. Hold one year in seed flat before transplanting.

Seed ripens end of July early August. Macerate the fruits; in water the viable seed sinks.

Seed source influences the successful growth rate of this plants. Seed from the Meeker, CO station has worked well, but they are difficult to work with. Other sources Fort Collins Wholesale Nursery has tried have not worked well. (eg. Seeds from Pleasant Avenue Nursery, Buena Vista; DBG works but seed extremely sparse)
