Seed			
Treatments (Suggested procedures)			
Does not root well. Scarification not necessary. Cold/moist stratify seed in strat bags for 120-150 days at 41° F or fall sow in outdoor seed bed. Use fresh seed; seed viability is highest in first year, low in second year and unacceptably low in the third year.			
Collection Timing and Strategies			
Collect first week in October. Allow hips to ferment for one week to soften the pulp, then macerate in Dybvig seed cleaner. Dry seed on newspaper blotter for two days and store in ziploc bags in the cooler at 41° F.

Full sun, dry to moderate soil moisture. 6-8' tall, with widely arching branches.
