Seed germinates in 3 to 4 days at 70-75F and with relative humidity above 70%, cover seed with soil or vermiculite.

<b>Greenhouse conditions</b>				
Plugs-After germination, grow at temperature 65 down to 55F for 3 to 4 weeks gradually drying and cooling, may require plant growth regulators. After transplant, plant grow best with medium to dry soil media, fertilize with a complete low ammonia and low phosphorus complete fertilizer at about 250ppm Nitrogen per week.				
<b>Garden conditions</b>				
Use well draining soil, keep soil moist for first few weeks then allow soil to dry between irrigations. Rudbeckia can tolerate very low levels of water if conditioned gradually. Typically, drier grow plants stay more compact.				
<b>Other Expert Advice</b>				
Requires over 14 hours of light (10 foot candles) to flower.
