Treatments (Suggested procedures)					

Germinates readily without pretreatment. Sow and cover to a depth equal to the diameter of the seed. With intermittent mist and bottom heat, germination usually starts in 4-6 days. Remove plug trays from the mist one week after germination begins, and keep plugs moist until they are ready to transplant. Plugs should be ready to transplant in about 45-60 days.

# **Collection Timing and Strategies**

Collect seed in mid-summer when seed pods start to turn brown.

### **Cultural Information**

#### Greenhouse conditions

Water early in the day to allow the pubescent foliage to dry in the sun. Provide a relatively light dose of fertilizer (75 ppm Nitrogen) twice per week to avoid excessive vegetative growth. Water judiciously to prevent foliar and root rots.

#### Garden conditions

Plants perform best in full sun, but will tolerate light shade. Plant in well-drained soil and provide moderate amounts of water.

## **Other Expert Advice**

Flowers are an excellent source of nectar for hummingbirds. Spent flowers are unattractive; deadhead for appearance and to prevent unwanted seed development.
