Treatments (Suggested procedures)

Grow plants from seed. In DBG trials the best germination was at 70 days and no covering to the seed. Seed takes about 10 days to start germination and can take 6 weeks to be large enough to transplant.

Collection Timing and Strategies

Seed should be collected in Sept or Oct when plants are mature. Asteraceous species can be very difficult to clean and process due to the high numbers of non viable empty seed.

Cultural Information

Greenhouse conditions

Plants can be susceptable to damping off and should be allowed to dry between watering and grown where there is good air circulation.

Garden conditions

Best grown in full sun in well draining soil.

Other Expert Advice

Weekly 100ppm Zero-Tol drench helps keep down on damping off. Plants at DBG grown in moderate shade became stretched and needed to be pruned before going out to the gardens.
