Treatments (Suggested procedures)

Two-inch tip cuttings should be treated with a 1:10 liquid rooting hormone. Place under intermittent mist for approximately 8 days. After root initiation occurs remove from mist and keep soil evenly moist until rooting has finished.

Collection Timing and Strategies

Cuttings can be harvested any time plant is actively growing. Remove inflorescence from cutting material.

Cultural Information

Greenhouse conditions

Plants are adaptable to a wide variety of cultural conditions. Excess water can cause leaching of nutrients and susceptibility to water-borne diseases.

Garden conditions

Best grown in full sun in areas that don't stay wet for extended periods of time.

Other Expert Advice

In greenhouse conditions plants can be susceptibility to whitefly and spider mites.
