Treatments (Suggested procedures)

Stick 1 1/2" to 2" tip and stem cuttings with more than 2 nodes into any well-draining media (stick as a 2-per for fuller liners). No rooting hormone is necessary. Place under intermittent mist for up to 10 days. Liners root in appx 6 weeks.

Collection Timing and Strategies

Cuttings can be taken any time plant is actively growing. Moderate flowering does not affect rooting.

Cultural Information

Greenhouse conditions

Requires the same growing conditions as other creeping Veronicas. Well spaced #1 or hanging baskets work well for stock plants, producing a large number of cuttings per plant. Recovery from cutback takes appx 4 weeks when actively growing. Do not overwater. Does well in any finished size with appropriate watering.

Garden conditions

Full to part-sun, well-draining soil. Additional irrigation during the hottest summer heat will keep foliage bright green.

Other Expert Advice

Susceptible to aphids.
