Germination at 60F. Cover seed. Germination should occur in 14 to 21 days

Seed will constantly be developing, however the capsules will shatter when seed is ripe.

Greenhouse conditions				
Grow at soil temperatures of 65F during plug stage. Seed to transplant is usually 7 to 8 weeks.				
Garden conditions				
Other Expert Advice				
Put plug trays in a cooler for 2 days after sowing. Freezing seed may also help increase germination.
