Cuttings				
Treatments (Suggested procedures)				
Take cuttings of about 2 inches, remove leaves from lower 3/4s of the stem and dip into rooting hormone. We use Hormodin 2 powder. Cuttings are placed in a moist mixture of 3 parts Perlite to 1 part bagged sterile soil mix (peat and perlite), under intermittent mist. Bottom heat helps promote rooting, but is not absolutely necessary.				
Collection Timing and Strategies				
Cuttings can be taken any time plant has vegetative stems. Cuttings usually root in 3-5 weeks.

Add perlite to soil for transplant. Plants are prone to rotting in early stages after transplant.
