Treatments (Suggested procedures)
--

For seed pre-soaking the seed may speed up germination. Seed will also germinate if kept wet. For cuttings use a talc-based rooting hormone. Do not put under mist. Sub irrigate or hand water. Rooting medium should be either sand or perlite.

Collection Timing and Strategies

Cuttings should come from non-flowering stems that have matured but not turned woody.

Cultural Information

Greenhouse conditions

Prefers hotter temperatures, must be kept moist until roots become established. Does not require much fertilizer in early stages.

Garden conditions

Native to the Mojave desert and thrives in arid and full sun environments. Avoid overwatering. Soil types can be varied but prefer well drained soils.

Other expert Advice

Prefers mineral soils. Can show signs of stress in organic based medium.
