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Executive Summary

In June of 2014 plants of nineteen taxa were planted at Denver Botanic Gardens' Chatfield Farms (Littleton, CO) and Colorado State University's Plant Environmental Research Center (Fort Collins, CO) for evaluation for attributes desirable of plants in the Plant Select® Program. These taxa represented nineteen species, seventeen genera, and nine botanical families.

Within months of planting, staff at DBG dictated that all plants of *Dieteria bigelovii* ssp. *begelovii* (*Machaeranthera pattersonii*) be removed from the evaluation areas and destroyed.

The remaining eighteen taxa were left in the ground and evaluated the following spring for overwinter survival. One taxa, *Salvia* WINDWALKER® Coral Pink Salvia, and introduction from Timberline Gardens, had no plants surviving after the winter of 2014-2015. Another taxa, *Stipa gigantea* UNDAUNTED® 'Lauren's Hardy', had no plants surviving at CSU-PERC after the winter of 2014-2015, however a few plants did survive at DBG-Chatfield Farms.

The remaining seventeen taxa were evaluated and periodically measured throughout the 2015 growing season. Of those seventeen taxa, three displayed attributes desirable of plants in the Plant Select® Program: *Limonium minutum*, *Lavandula angustifolia* 'Wee One' and *Sorghastrum nutans* 'Thin Man'. Of the remaining fourteen taxa, specific plants of three of those taxa were selected and additional plants from these plants will be propagated during the fall and winter of 2015-2016, and plants of these selections will be planted in 2016 for evaluation during 2016 and 2017. The species for which selections were made are *Scutellaria scordiifolia*, *Teucrium hircanicum*, and *Trachelium jacquinii* ssp. *rumelianum*.

This report is a compilation of the research data collected from the evaluations at DBG-Chatfield Farms and CSU-PERC.

Observations:

*DBG-Chatfield ~

- ◇ Plants severely damaged by grasshopper feeding (must be caged to prevent predation).
- ◇ Plant growth quite different compared to plants at CSU-PERC.
- ◇ Plants at DBG-Chatfield much smaller than those at CSU-PERC.

+CSU-PERC ~

- ◇ Mounds of fine-texture foliage covered with tiny yellow flowers.
- ◇ Plants cutback to within a few inches of the ground in early July did not regrow.
- ◇ Plants die when cut back to ground in July.
- ◇ New growth occurred in September in center of plants that were not cutback.


- ◇ Beautiful groundcover; striking while in bloom.
- ◇ Foliage became chlorotic and plants tended to die in their centers.

+CSU-PERC ~

- ◇ Plants form low mats of gray-green foliage.
- ◇ Foliage became chlorotic and plants tended to die in their centers.
- ◇ Plants cutback in early July did not rebloom.

Observations:

*DBG-Chatfield ~

- ◇ Beautiful pink blooms and growth habit.
- ◇ Great hummingbird attractant!
- ◇ However, plants were inconsistent in size and amount of blooms.

+CSU-PERC ~

- ◇ Attractive pink flowers in mid-July.
- ◇ Most plants grow to be large plants with long branches that arch over when weighted down with elongated fruits.
- ◇ One plant did not produce fruits; this was given to DBG for propagation for evaluation in 2016.

*DBG-Chatfield ~

- ◇ Slight size variations due to watering differences as all are clones.
- ◇ Blooms repeatedly after deadheading; lovely smell!
- ◇ Great pollinator attractant!
- ◇ Plants form mounds about 30 cm tall with abundant spikes of fragrant light purple flowers.

+CSU-PERC ~

- ◇ Not grown.

- ◇ Flowers appear from July through September.
- ◇ Flower stalks lodge later in season.
- ◇ Foliage browns at tips later in season.

+CSU-PERC ~

- ◇ Attractive mound of foliage when not in bloom.
- ◇ Plants form mounds about 20 cm tall with taller cymes of light purple flowers.
- ◇ Flower stalks on some plants became floppy.

- ◇ Foliage of plants damaged by grasshopper.
- ◇ Leaf margins tended to brown and become dry.

+CSU-PERC ~

- ◇ Plants form mounds 30-60 cm tall with attractive blue flowers in June.
- ◇ Spent flowers followed by small spiny fruits that attached to clothing.
- ◇ Plants cutback in early July did not rebloom; however cutback plants produced mounds with attractive foliage.

- ◇ Should deadhead after bloom.
- ◇ No self-seeding observed.
- ◇ Wide variation in shape and size.
- ◇ Spent inflorescences look much different compared to those of plants at CSU-PERC.

+CSU-PERC ~

- ◇ Attractive gray-green foliage and light purple flowers.
- ◇ Plants cutback in early July did not rebloom.
- ◇ Spent inflorescences look much different compared to those of plants at DBG-Chatfield.
- ◇ Prolific self-seeding observed; hundred of seedlings counted within 24”.



- ◇ Blooms repeatedly after deadheading.
- ◇ Selection made; all other plants removed.

+CSU-PERC ~

- ◇ Attractive green foliage.
- ◇ Attractive purple flowers.
- ◇ Long bloom time from mid-June through September.
- ◇ Plants cutback in early July rebloomed through remainder of summer.

- ◇ Great pollinator attractant!
- ◇ Should deadhead after bloom.
- ◇ Flower stalks lodge and break.
- ◇ Possible prolific seeder.

+CSU-PERC ~

- ◇ Attractive airy green foliage and white inflorescences.
- ◇ Attractive to large assortment of insects.
- ◇ Only a few of the plants cutback in early July rebloomed.
- ◇ Most plants became tan in color after blooming and produced prolific amount of seeds.

- ◇ Plants inconsistent in shape, size, and foliage color.
- ◇ Foliage browns and curls later in season.
- ◇ Selections could be made for preferred plants.

+CSU-PERC ~

- ◇ Attractive bright green foliage with sparse spike-like inflorescences of purplish-pink flowers.
- ◇ Plants cutback in early July did not rebloom.
- ◇ Plants that were cutback formed low mounds of attractive bright-green foliage.

*DBG-Chatfield ~

- ◇ Great pollinator attractant!
- ◇ Blooms repeatedly after deadheading.
- ◇ Selections were made for continued evaluation.
- ◇ Hundred of seedlings counted within 24"; seedlings as far as 6'.

+CSU-PERC ~

- ◇ Attractive green foliage and reddish-purple flowers that are attractive to many species of pollinators.
- ◇ Plants bloomed throughout the Summer and early Fall.
- ◇ Plants cutback in early July did rebloom.
- ◇ Much variation in size among plants.
- ◇ A selection was made for continued evaluation.
- ◇ Self-seeding was not observed.



Trachelium jacquinii ssp. rumelianum

Observations:

*DBG-Chatfield ~

- ◇ One plant, very small.
- ◇ Inflorescence of white flowers.
- ◇ Much more successful at CSU than DBG.

+CSU-PERC ~

- ◇ Attractive small mounds green foliage most of the summer.
- ◇ Produced umbels of light-purple flowers in later summer; these are attractive to many species of pollinators.
- ◇ Weight of inflorescences causes plants to become open in their centers.
- ◇ Plants became very unattractive after blooming.
